The basis of this layout was the famous cable-suspended layout of the late Don Oldendorf of Placentia. Don's layout was moved to Fullerton and placed in a long, deep garage. The original scenery has been replaced with a 1900s Western theme with equipment and structures to match. The revised layout features a generous lap-type mainline. Most motive power is steam and trains are a mix of freight and passenger.
