<p>The area between Texas and California is represented in this two-car garage layout set in the mid-1940s to mid-1950s. The approach is freelance but very general elements of Los Angeles and Houston are modeled on a point-to-point track plan featuring three levels, sweeping curves and three percent grades. Railroads represented are Santa Fe and Missouri Pacific. Control is maintained through four cabs with optional Aristo-Craft wireless throttles.</p>

<p>Jeff's layout is based on logging operations in 1930s Oregon as would have been seen between the railroad's namesake towns of Tigard and Grants Pass. He is building a series of shadow boxes which will highlight individual scenes through which trains will operate. Control is DCC. The shadow box design will allow for easier relocation of the railroad should a move become necessary.</p>
